

## #5 "MIRACLES"

Psalm 127:1

Miracles can happen in your house.

A miracle is a supernatural intervention of God to solve a problem, change a circumstance or situation, bring breakthrough or deliverance, divine help or healing — do the humanly impossible.

**Matthew 8:14-16 (NIV)** When Jesus came into Peter's house, He saw Peter's mother-in-law lying in bed with a fever. He touched her hand and the fever left her ... When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to Him, and He drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick.

**Luke 8:41, 42 (NIV)** Then a man named Jairus, a ruler of the synagogue, came and fell at Jesus' feet, pleading with Him to come to his house because his only daughter, a girl of about twelve, was dying ...

**Luke 8:51-55 (NIV)** When He arrived at the house of Jairus, He did not let anyone go in with Him except Peter, John and James, and the child's father and mother ... He took her by the hand and said, "My child, get up!" Her spirit returned, and at once she stood up. Then Jesus told them to give her something to eat.

**Acts 9:36, 37 (NIV)** In Joppa there was a disciple named Tabitha ... who was always doing good and helping the poor ... she became sick and died, and her body was washed and placed in an upstairs room.

**Acts 9:39-41 (NIV)** Peter went with them, and when he arrived he was taken upstairs to the room ... Peter sent them all out of the room; then he got down on his knees and prayed. Turning toward the dead woman, he said, "Tabitha, get up." She opened her eyes, and seeing Peter she sat up. He took her by the hand and helped her to her feet. Then he called the believers and the widows and presented her to them alive.

How do we prepare our houses for God's miraculous grace and power?

**A** = Ask God.

**S** = Stand in and with faith.

- Know God's promises.
- Believe God's promises.
- Claim God's promises.
- Rest in God's promises.
- Wait on God's promises.

**Matthew 7:11 (NIV)** If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask Him!

**James 4:2 (NIV)** ... You do not have, because you do not ask God.

**K** = Keep an atmosphere of worship, gratitude and praise.
